(Students, who are currently in grade 9 and going into grade 10 in September 2022 are eligible to apply)
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, sports coach, or adult who is not the applicant's parent or guardian
- Can commit to 5-7 hours per month
- Fluent in English
- Team Player
- Fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and can produce a BC Vaccine Card if admitted into the program
