## MOBILE LIFT — COMMUNITY HEALTH, \$7,500

Mobile Lifts are used to help patients move from seated to standing positions and adapt to individual patient needs. They also reduce the potential for strain and injury in medical staff.

## ARJO RHAPSODY TUB SYSTEM — RESIDENTIAL CARE, \$30,000

This specialized bathtub system is designed for flexibility and is compatible with a range of transport and lifting aids that cover all resident mobility levels. A complete system enables one caregiver to safely manage the entire bathing cycle. Bath features and options can be combined to create therapeutic systems (i.e. hydro-massage) that suit the specific needs of residents at PAH.

## STRYKER BED & MATTRESS — RESIDENTIAL CARE, \$16,000

The complex adjustable Stryker Beds are fundamental in providing care to our elderly patients, especially those with mobility issues in Residential Care. Getting in and out of bed can be a challenge for many reasons, and the adjust-ability and special features of these beds ensure that the residents can start and end their safely, in line with their physical limitations.

## GLIDESCOPE — EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT, \$7,500

This NEW tool is a flexible, lighted tube which is placed in through the mouth of nose to help doctors obtain a better view of the nasopharynx. In short, it helps physicians check the area for abnormal growths, bleeding, or other problems. It also makes for easier airway management in difficult conditions, such as neonatal intubation, morbidly obese patients or a restricted view of the laryngeal inlet.

## BLADDER SCANNER — PACU, \$14,000

This is a diagnostic tool used to improve the diagnoses and differentiation of various bladder problems. It is a hand-held ultrasound device which will help perform quick, easy and non-invasive scans of the bladder and other areas.

This item is critically needed for the Post-Anesthesia Care Unit at Peace Arch Hospital.

## VEIN VIEWER — SURGERY, \$22,300

This proven technology enables accurate visualization of the veins under the skin during surgical procedures. It also provides a real time accurate image of the patient's blood pattern.



## SPECIALTY MATTRESS — RESIDENTIAL CARE, \$7,000

Designed for high acuity patients with limited mobility and compromised skin integrity, the Auralis Alternating Pressure Mattress System assists caregivers in managing a patient's needs to minimize the risk and burden of pressure injury.

## VITAL SIGN MONITOR — PRIMARY CARE, \$4,500

## VIDEO CYSTOSCOPE — SURGERY, \$20,000

During a cystoscopy, a urinary tract specialist (urologist) uses a cystoscope to view the inside of the bladder and urethra.

## **HOLTER MONITOR — CARDIAC DEPARTMENT, \$12,000**

The Holter monitor is a type of portable electrocardiogram (ECG). It records the electrical activity of the heart continuously over 24 hours or longer while a patient is away from the doctor's office.

A standard or "resting" ECG is one of the simplest and fastest tests used to evaluate the heart.

## **WATER DISPENSER & ICE MACHINE — SURGERY AND MEDICAL OUTPATIENT UNITS, \$7,000**

Hospital ice is used for wound care, physical therapy, and hydration.

## **BED BLANKET WARMER — SURGERY AND RESIDENTIAL CARE UNITS, \$7,500**

This important machine helps pre-warm blankets for patients, benefiting them psychologically as well as prepping them for surgery, recovering from surgery, or relieving pain.

## **SIMULATOR TABLET MONITOR — EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT, \$20,000**

This device assists with simulation exercises in the Emergency Department with the aim of medical team development and training for less frequent or high acuity emergencies.

## **PORTABLE LIGHT SOURCE — SURGERY, \$8,900**

These powerful, re-chargeable and portable lights assist surgeons in achieving maximum vision during difficult surgical procedures.

## **MOTORIZED PARALLEL BARS — REHAB DEPARTMENT, \$15,000**

These motorized, parallel bars are used in physical therapy to provide a safe and comfortable walking rehabilitation treatment for all patients, and even accommodate the bariatric population.



## **PORTABLE ULTRASOUND — SURGERY, \$45,000**

These handheld ultrasound devices will be used for cardiac screening exams, to diagnose obstetrical and abdominal complaints, and as a rapid triage tool during surgical procedures.
