Dan Crompton

Peace Arch Hospital's New Head of ER

Dr. Dan Crompton originally started his career as a chemical engineer before applying to medical school, after a couple of years in the engineering field. Born in Kelowna, he did his engineering training at UBC and then his medical degree at both UBC and UNBC in Prince George, in their joint program.

Dan says what attracted him to emergency medicine was the team aspect and the opportunity to treat patients in all specialties, from minor to acute.

“It’s an exhilarating learning opportunity,” he says. “There is something new every day and it’s so rewarding.”

With the opening of Peace Arch Hospital’s new ER, Dan has seen firsthand the impact the expanded facility has had. He joined Peace Arch in 2016 and since 2021 has been the department head.

“The infrastructure of our new unit is fantastic. Every treatment room has full functionality and privacy, which is something we didn’t have in the old ER. The trauma bay has amazing equipment, and the new C-Arm portable x-ray (funded by two generous Foundation donors) has been a game-changer for our patients.”

Dan says the biggest challenge he and his colleagues are facing right now is the system-wide deficit in resources such as the family doctor shortage.

“The ER is the catch-all for everything and when someone doesn’t have a family doctor and often can’t get into a walk-in clinic, they end up here, when what they really need is a primary care physician. This creates congestion which attributes to the sometimes long waits for patients. Primary health care in BC is a big issue and the system is really stretched right now.”

Peace Arch Hospital’s ER is currently seeing an average of 180-190 patients per day, which is over capacity, even for the new expanded unit which is triple the size of the previous ER.

The huge impact that the pandemic has had on medicine in general has resulted in many physicians, nurses, and other medical techs stepping away from the profession, either from exhaustion or burn-out, or both.

While the hardworking team at Peace Arch does its best to provide exceptional care, one thing Dan wants to emphasize is how grateful he is to our philanthropic donors who fund much of the equipment that helps him do his job.



The care we provide would simply not be possible without the generosity of this community,” he says. “I think about that every time I use the portable x-ray, and myriad other pieces of amazing equipment in our ER. Peace Arch may be a small hospital but the facilities and equipment available right here in White Rock is extraordinary.”

YOUTH-DRIVEN Program Fundraising Takes Big Strides IN WHITE ROCK

Peace Arch Hospital Foundation's Youth in Action program, launched in Spring 2021, was designed for students in grades 10-12 in White Rock and South Surrey who want to make a difference, get hands-on volunteer experience, and get involved with helping to make their community the healthiest possible.

The program is the first of its kind in our community and offers an exciting opportunity for youth to step outside of their comfort zone, learn, and grow after a year of navigating life from home during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

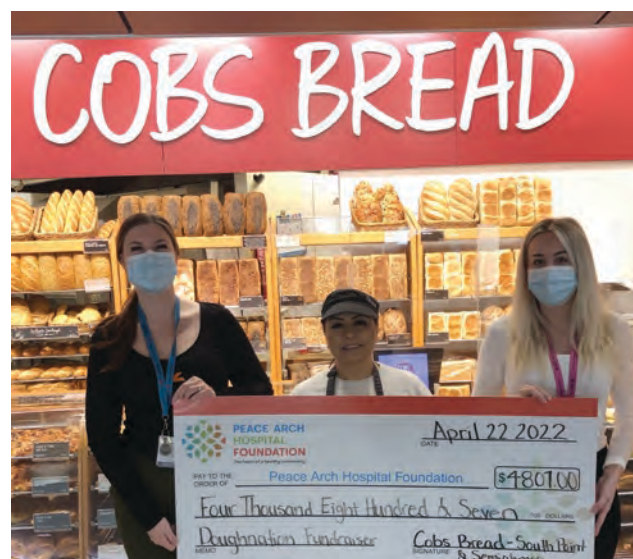
McHappier Days are Ahead

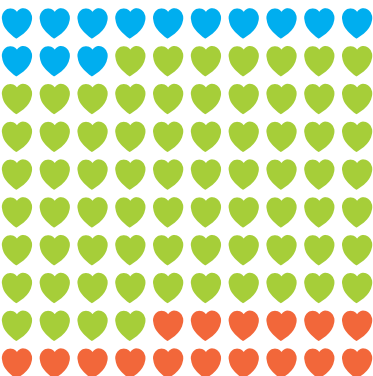

Sources of fundraising revenue:

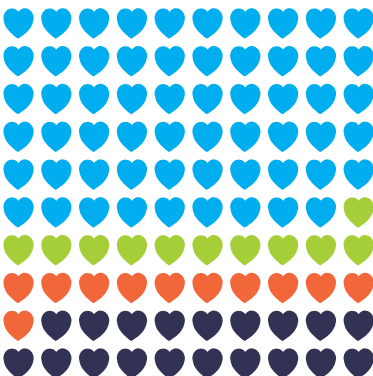

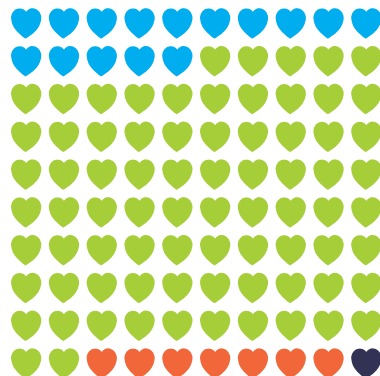
